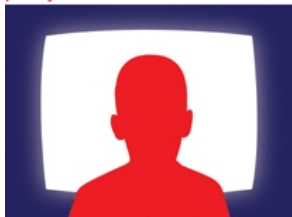

The Internet and other communications technologies are increasingly used by sexual predators and abusers as tools for exploiting and victimizing our children. These technologies have contributed to a significant increase in the proliferation and severity of child pornography. Additionally, as the Internet and related technologies have grown, children have become at much higher risk of being sexually solicited online by predators.
